Dear Professor Evans,

It is my pleasure to present to you the second annual report on behalf of the Dutch National Preventive Mechanisms (NPMs). This report has been developed as a joint effort by the different NPMs.

The NPMs conclude that the rights of persons that have been deprived of their freedom in the Netherlands are generally respected adequately. Several shortcomings, that were observed in earlier years, have been addressed. However, improvements remain desirable. For example with regards to the continuity and stability in qualified staff and a meaningful activity programme. Further, special attention is necessary for the physical interventions in juvenile institutions (Jeugdzorg<sup>plus</sup>), the regime in immigration detention centres, the manner in which restrictive measures are applied in residential care for the elderly and persons with a physical or mental disability.

The annual report will be presented, together with the other NPMs, to the Secretary of State of the Ministry of Security and Justice. The report will also be made public on our website.
